108.19 Public Participation

Residents advised of their objections to the planning application for the former One Stop premises. The potential for noise from the outside seating area and lack of parking provision were mentioned and it was felt the type of business was not suitable for a residential area.

19/00734/FUL Change of use of domestic swimming pool (use class C3) for leisure use (Use class D2) at1 Lydiate Lane

19/00574/FUL Change of use from A1 to A4 Café Bistro with seating to frontage and barriers to carparking at One-stop, 221 The Green. An amended application, removing the car parking spaces, has been submitted. Councillors raised concerns regarding the impact of noise from the outside seating area on neighbouring residential properties and the lack of parking facilities.

Resolved: an objection is to be lodged on the grounds of unsuitable development in a residential area. Noise from the premises will adversely affect neighbouring properties. The lack of parking is contrary to standards within the Chorley Local Plan. A request for the application to be determined by Chorley Council's Planning Committee is also to be submitted
